Subject: Status of Packaging Compliance Assessment under Regulation (EU) 2025/40 on Packaging and Packaging Waste (PPWR)

Motul is actively assessing the compliance of its packaging portfolio with the requirements of Regulation (EU) 2025/40 on Packaging and Packaging Waste (PPWR).

As of 12 August 2026, the implementation framework for certain PPWR provisions remains under development. Several delegated acts, implementing acts, technical methodologies and guidance documents required to support the assessment and formal demonstration of compliance have not yet been published or finalized by the European Commission. Industry associations have highlighted that some PPWR requirements cannot yet be fully assessed due to the absence of the corresponding implementation measures.

To date, Motul has collected and assessed available technical information relating to its packaging, including packaging specifications, material composition data and available recyclability-related information.

The assessment of certain PPWR requirements remains ongoing and is dependent on additional information currently being collected from packaging suppliers and other actors in the supply chain. Some substance-related declarations and supporting documentation are not yet fully available.

Based on the information currently available to Motul, including data received from its packaging suppliers, no issue has been identified that would prevent the packaging concerned from continuing to be placed on the European Union market. Nevertheless, the completion of the PPWR conformity assessment remains dependent on the publication of outstanding implementing measures and guidance by the European Commission, as well as the availability of certain supplier data currently being collected.

Motul remains committed to supporting its customers throughout the PPWR implementation process and will provide updated compliance information as additional regulatory guidance and supplier documentation become available.

This statement reflects the information available to Motul on the date of issue and may be revised as regulatory requirements, official guidance and supplier information evolve. This document is provided for information purposes only and shall not be considered a formal Declaration of Conformity under Regulation (EU) 2025/40.
